



Do I have to sign up for the entire camp duration, or can I enroll my child for specific days?

No, you do not need to sign your child up for the entire camp duration. However, the earlier we know your child will be joining us, the better we can plan and tailor activities to enhance their experience.

What age group is the camp designed for?

The camp is designed for children from **rising kindergarten to fourth grade**. We divide the groups based on each child's skill set to target their development accordingly. If your child is under or over this age range, please contact us. We may be able to accommodate the camp if there are enough sign-ups within that range.

What are the camp hours and schedule?

Camp starts at **9:00 AM, with drop-off beginning at 8:45 AM. Pick-up is promptly at 2:00 PM.** Please be on time, as late arrivals or departures can disrupt our activities. Additionally, our center is used for individual therapy sessions after camp. Please be mindful to leave promptly at pick-up time.

What specific skills will my child be working on in math, handwriting, and reading?

Math Fluency: Depending on your child's level, we will work on number sense, addition, subtraction, multiplication, and solving word problems.

Handwriting: Based on your child's needs, we target goal that will promote the handwriting efficiency. These may include grasp pattern, sizing, spacing, and letter formation. For more advanced students we incorporate writing prompts to enhance their skills.

Reading Skills: We focus on reading comprehension, storytelling immersion, and group reading activities. Children will practice understanding passages, answering questions, and engaging with texts. Please note that we do not work on decoding skills but rather on reading immersion and comprehension.

Executive Functioning: These skills will be developed through structured daily routines that mimic a school setting. This includes group following, organization, and management. Additionally, executive functioning skills will be targeted through project-based activities that involve sequencing, gathering materials, and completing tasks according to instructions.

Social Smarts: We are targeting Social skills during lunch with direct teaching of lessons like learning about peers and group collaboration. Children will be immersed in learning to work in teams and to navigate their interactions with therapist support.



What is the camper-to-staff ratio to ensure individualized attention?

Our target **camper-to-staff ratio is 1:4**, ensuring each child receives individualized attention and support throughout their camp experience.

Are there any themes or special activities each day?

Yes! Each day features a unique Growth Mindset theme like **Embracing Challenges, Making Mistakes, The Power of Yet, Perseverance, Attitude of Gratitude, Empathy** and others designed to make every day of camp exciting and engaging.
